#### **I. New York State Department of Environmental (NYSDEC)**

#### **Neighborhood Remediation Update**

##### **Remedial Design & Construction**

No significant remedial activities have occurred in the past month. Field work has stopped for the winter and will commence again in the spring. In the meantime, NYSDEC and its engineer are working on construction reports and remedial designs for 2020.

#### **II. Foundry Remediation**

Foundry remediation and restoration is complete. Some additional releveling of the area and spraying for poison ivy will be handled in early Spring.

#### **III. Resident outreach – City of Geneva**
