- The Collective Group (for those who have not been following) is a group of stakeholders in our community complied to submit recommendations and suggestions on current policies in place for the City of Geneva Police Department. The Collective is charged to ensure that said policies are reformed to help reflect the needs of the community, moreover the needs of communities that have disproportionately impacted by systemic racism with respect to policing. This has led to or resulted in distrust of government intuitions including the distrust of the GPD.
- The Collective Group have begun work sessions, subgroups work together on a section of said policy then report back to larger group on Tuesday for discussion and other suggestions from members.
- The Collective have reviewed to date
 - Use of Force Policy
 - CIT (Crisis Intervention Team)
 - Equitable Policing
 - Crime Prevention and Community Policing will be the next topic on Tuesday.
- As part of EO 203 community input is key in this process moving forward, with that said the collective group will be pushing out a Community survey that can be found on the City website. We encourage all residents to participate.
